



Putnam County Economic Development Activity Report

January-March 2025

Pursuant to the provisions of the Economic Development Agreement made and entered into between the Putnam County Board of County Commissioners and the Putnam County Chamber of Commerce.

<u>I. New & Existing Business Development:</u>

- Currently working with 18 clients interested in either attraction/relocation or expanding existing operations in Putnam County. Of the 18 clients, 5 are confidential attraction leads from Florida Commerce/JAXUSA, 10 are organic Attraction Leads and 3 are local Existing Industries considering Expanding Operations.
- These represent collectively **4,045** new jobs and over **\$2.3 Billion** in capital investment to the county if they come to fruition.
- Reviewed 8 other RFPs but Putnam County ineligible as requests were for existing buildings that we do not have available.
- Continue retention visits and meetings with local businesses/industry.
- 2023 Announced Expansion Project at CertainTeed Gypsum is under-construction with a planned opening in early 2025.
- Supporting significant Tourism Resort Project in South Putnam

II. Related Agencies:

- Maintained working relationships with Florida Commerce, JAXUSA Partnership, FPL, Clay Electric, NFEDP, FEDC, SEDC, IEDC, CSX, TECO Gas and other economic development agencies.
- Represented Putnam County at NFEDP Board & Executive Committee meetings and we
 hosted the February 7th Quarterly NFEDP Board Meeting at Ravine Gardens with over
 130 people representing 15 counties.
- Represented Putnam County at JAXUSA Regional Partner & Business Development Committee meetings.
- Presented Putnam County Update at JAXUSA "State of the Region" event in JAX.
- Continue to work with Local Technology Planning Team on broadband initiatives.
- Continue to work with SBDC representative on local business/entrepreneurial assistance.

III. Other Activities:

- Florida Scorecard named Putnam County the #1 County for Job Growth in 2024! (See attached) Putnam had a 2.4% growth rate of primary jobs. In comparison, St Johns had 1.2%, Clay 1.1%, Bradford 0.2%, and Alachua 1.1%.
- Hosted first 2025 PCEDC Quarterly Investor Luncheon in March with 65 attendees.
- Hosted first 2025 Elevate Putnam Investor Advisory Council Meeting
- Attended Rural County Days in Tallahassee and supported Putnam County Legislative Priorities
- Continue to meet with City of Palatka in support of water/wastewater infrastructure solutions.
- Attended First Coast Expressway Summit FDOT reported Phase III is scheduled to be complete in 2030.
- Relaunched the Putnam Chamber Workforce Development Task Force bringing together all local educational training providers, CareerSource, and major employers in Putnam County.
