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Sunroom Classification

In accordance with the Florida Residential Building Code, section R301.2.1.1, sunrooms are required to be categorized based on the intended use in one of the following categories by the permit applicant, design professional, or the property owner where the sunroom is being constructed.

Indicate the applicable sunroom category for your project:

_____ **Category I:** A thermally isolated sunroom with walls that are either open or enclosed with insect screening or 0.5 mm (20 mil) maximum thickness plastic film. The openings shall be permitted to be enclosed with insect screening or 0.5 mm (20 mil) maximum thickness plastic film. The space is defined as a non-habitable and non-conditioned sunroom.

_____ **Category II:** A thermally isolated sunroom with enclosed walls. The openings are permitted to be enclosed with translucent or transparent plastic or glass. The space is defined as a non-habitable and non-conditioned sunroom.

_____ **Category III:** A thermally isolated sunroom with enclosed walls. The openings are permitted to be enclosed with translucent or transparent plastic or glass. The sunroom fenestration complies with additional requirements for air infiltration resistance and water penetration resistance. The space is defined as a non-habitable and non-conditioned sunroom.

_____ **Category IV:** A thermally isolated sunroom with enclosed walls. The sunroom is designed to be heated and/or cooled by a separate temperature control or system and is thermally isolated from the primary structure. The sunroom fenestration complies with additional requirements for air infiltration resistance, water penetration resistance, and thermal performance. The space is defined as a non-habitable and conditioned sunroom.

_____ **Category V:** A roof or a covering of an outdoor space with enclosed walls. The sunroom is designed to be heated and/or cooled and is open to the main structure. The sunroom fenestration complies with additional requirements for air infiltration resistance, water penetration resistance, and thermal performance. The space is defined as a habitable and conditioned sunroom.
