I want to start off by thanking you for your efforts on this draft Data Center Moratorium and appreciate the transparency that you are offering the public by allowing them to be a part of the process.

Unfortunately, I am unable to attend the meeting in person tomorrow so I wanted to pass along some concerns I have via e-mail. I have concerns that the draft language is not strict enough. A moratorium is intended to be a temporary ban while real restrictions/legislation gets created. By including exceptions, this reduces the effectiveness of the moratorium. I believe any exceptions should be considered when drafting the long-term ordinances, not as part of the moratorium.

Again, thank you for including the public in the planning process for this moratorium. I look forward to hearing how the meeting goes tomorrow.
